

### Biography

- Pier Paolo Pasolini was born in Bologna on 5th March 1922 and he died in Ostian on 2nd November 1975.
- He was an Italian film director, poet, intellectual, philosopher, novelist, screenwriter and writer.
- Pasolini began writing poetry when he was seven years old. When he attended the University of Bologna, he also served in the Second World War.



#### Poem analysis

- During his live, Pasolini had a passionate love for his mother. According to the poem, his mother was indifferent to him, and when Pasolini returned home he was crying and he was very sad because of his mother's attitude.
- He said "with my mother, I was, like all my life, tied with a passionate love without hope."

- Another poem that shows the love between child and mother is "Mum" by Gerasimos Markoras.
